- > Earnestly pray for the success of the lineup of the activities of the Diocese in this quarter and the rest of the year.
- > Dedicate a good amount of time to pray for the success of our Diocesan 15th Anniversary celebrations and the synod of this year.
- > Pray for good health and God's grace for the Bishop, clergy and other ministers in the Diocese.
- Ceaselessly pray for the manifestation of this year's Diocesan Theme "Unlimited Advancement & All-Round Fruitfulness" in the life of members of our Diocese.
- > Pray for Divine direction for the Diocese through the leadership of the Bishop, the Clergy & other leaders.
- > Ask the Lord for spiritual, numerical and physical growth of all our churches and the grace on our part to labour towards these desires.
- > Earnestly pray against untimely death in our Diocese this year.
- > Every church should dedicate to pray for their overall growth and that of the Diocese.

Crucial instructions:

- > Take Note and Implement the OFFERING IN AID OF SPECIAL NEEDS (Every Sunday) as We have directed.
- Special Offerings in support of the mission of the Diocese are to be collected during special services such as birthdays, weddings, family/individual/group thanksgivings etc. which are celebrated during weekdays.
- > Churches should start early enough to raise offerings and mobilize towards mass attendance at DIVCCON, 2024.
- All Diocesan programmes and activities take precedence over those of churches and groups/individuals. Consequently, serious attention should be given to them in the daily/weekly announcements in all churches.
- The clergy should ensure that all those being prepared for Confirmation pay their N5, 000.00 Church of Nigeria Endowment Fund and that of the Diocese of Evo. They are to also purchase their personal copies of the BCP, CoN Hymnal and the Confirmation Manual, etc. without which such candidates should not be presented to the Bishop when he visits. Furthermore, other members of the church coming for weddings and churching of women after childbirth, Induction/Admission into CMF & MU/WG and other rites are to also pay their Endowment Funds or show proof of payment. This money is to be faithfully and fully remitted to the Diocese.

- > The Bishop frowns at the practice of clergymen taking their candidates prepared for confirmation or directing desiring members of their churches to other parishes or stations being visited by the Bishop for confirmation. Henceforth, this practice which the Bishop had severally objected to should be discontinued!
- Priests/Church Teachers in charge of churches/stations are to please endeavor to send in advance (2 weeks) to the Bishop a copy of the service programme for his scheduled visits to their churches.
- Leaders of Prayer Groups should carry out their activities as directed. Those whose Patron Saints' days fall within this quarter should celebrate them. The Chaplains and Diocesan Coordinators are to ensure compliance.
- Priests and their churches including the Activity Groups CMF, MU/WG, AYF, etc. are hereby reminded that they are to compulsorily patronize the Diocesan Printing Press for all their printing jobs for church services, conferences, special events, weddings, funerals, etc. and obtain payment receipts from the Press. Those who fail in this regard will be seriously sanctioned after necessary Diocesan audit.
- The Diocesan Bookshop at the All Saints Cathedral caters for all your stationeries, literature, vestments and Communion elements needs. Churches, institutions, priests and members of the Diocese are hereby encouraged to patronize it.
- > All churches and individuals still indebted to the Diocese in one way or the other are hereby reminded to clear all such debts without further delay.
- The clergy and members of all Church Family Life/Marriage Committees should ensure as a matter of Diocesan Policy that all couples preparing for their weddings in Evo Churches mandatorily carry out all their pre-wedding medical tests/examinations in our BEM Hospital. Similarly, all Diocesan schools Principals are to send to BEMH their newly admitted students/pupils and employed staff for their necessary medical examinations.
